### Instructions

- 1 Before you purchase your shoes, please take the time to measure the length of the insole of a current pair of sport shoes you wear.
- 2 Compare that number to the chart above and choose the correct size.
- 3 Sizing varies from manufacturer to manufacturer. As such, do not just order a size based on a different brand's sizes.
- 4 The correct way to measure is from the tip of the toe to the back of the heel, between the two furthest points.
- 5 All sizes are Unisex and only come in Regular width, unless specified herewith.
